Course fee includes some materials (does not include found object tesserae - BYO, substrates and glue), morning and afternoon teas, lunch Saturday and Sunday; (self-catering and independent finishing of work on Monday).

Helen will lead this course building on memory-ware folk traditions and exploring ideas around kitsch and material memory. Participants are encouraged to bring found object tesserae whose encapsulated memories are significant to them and which will be used in their found object and memory mosaic.

GET A GRIP – BEGINNER MOSAICS - 3 DAY WEEKEND

Course fee includes all mosaic materials (vitreous, porcelain and stone, substrates and glue), morning and afternoon teas, lunch Saturday and Sunday; (self-catering and independent finishing of work on Monday).

Beginning with an illustrated lecture on the origins of mosaic, Helen will help participants 'Get a Grip' on some of the options for contemporary practice, exploring both technical and conceptual aspects. She will demonstrate how to cut a wide range of materials including unglazed and glazed ceramic, vitrified glass, sheet glass and stone and introduce 'thinking in mosaic'. Course participants will make a small work on timber panel using materials of their choice. Open Access Studio Days for beginners will commence on 24 March, with a special introductory 20% discount for 'Get a Grip' participants.

PICASSIETTE - working with ceramic shards: 3 DAY WEEKEND

Helen will lead this course building on picassiette traditions ranging from the Catalan tradition of trencadis, to Raymond Isidore's work (see https://www.artsy.net/article/artsy-editorial-cemetery-caretaker-covered-cottage-mind-bending-mosaics) and working with central goldfields found blue and white-ware. Participants are encouraged to bring ceramic shards, either lost & found or custom created.

Translating a painting to mosaic requires a crucial process of design adaptation, as we seek to balance the strength of the original image with the unique characteristics of mosaic. Strong emphasis on planning andamento, together with nuanced palette handling form the focus of this course.
