Who should participate? This course will be suited to both experienced mosaicists and novice mosaic enthusiasts. Helen will take a different teaching approach with each person, based on their experience, capability and creative goals. It is the first time she has taught in Greece.

- More experienced mosaicists will be encouraged to make a work based on their own design, that is achievable using marble. Helen will be in touch with them via email before the course to preview their proposed design and ascertain the materials needed.
- Beginner mosaicists will be encouraged to make a work inspired by a local Greco-Roman mosaic. This is an age old a practice which accelerates learning by walking in the footsteps of the ancient master mosaicist, learning about pattern and the directional flow of mosaic tesserae (that we call *andamento*). Helen will contact registered workshop participants by email before the course, to offer them a range designs from which to choose.
- Helen's emphasis will lie in the interpretation of classical design and concept development, in order to make works that are distinctly contemporary. Students will use glass smalti and/or marble, handworked using both hammer & hardie, side nippers and wheeled nippers.

Optional Post-course mosaic study tour - more information available on request

Departing on Monday 3rd July course participants, accompanying persons and others are invited to join 6-day tour which will include: Dion, Meteora, Delphi, Osios Loukas Monastery, Corinth and Isthmia in the Athens as well as the Acropolis and Byzantine Museum workshop where mosaics are restored. All transfers, hotel accommodation and meals/expert guides ae included.

Course Tutor




Dr. Helen Bodycomb is well known as one of Australia's few contemporary artists working primarily in mosaic. She is widely professionally active; exhibiting, fulfilling commissions, guest teaching and presenting her work in conference presentations, nationally and internationally. Helen has been pivotal to re-defining mosaic as an art form in Australia, having initially trained as painter (Victoria College, 1988-1990 and Monash University, 1993-94), also working under Maestro Giulio Candussio in Spilimbergo, Italy in 2001. She has practiced full-time as a mosaic artist working predominantly in stone and glass for more than 25 years.

Helen also applies mosaic methodologies to more experimental artworks exploring ephemera and biodegradability, and conceptual modes she calls 'thinking in mosaic'. In August 2019 Helen completed her practice-led PhD in Visual Art with La Trobe University, Australia, her research project investigating *Mosaic: classical principles and the act of making in contemporary works.* This research sought to clarify and defend traditional mosaic conventions and assert how thinking in mosaic can augment wider contemporary art practice. Helen's practice spans three predominant streams: experimental fine art, community art/commissions and education – through annual art retreats / mosaic study tours.

The Village of Lafkos - South Pelion

Lafkos is one of the 24 officially 'listed' villages in the region of Pelion, about 45 km from the city of Volos. Medieval paths (Kalderimia) stretch around this car-free village and further afield to neighbouring villages and the sea. Three museums and five tavernas are open all year. The smell of freshly baked bread in a wood-fired oven draws you to the bakery shop. The village has three small 'mini-markets', a craftsman jeweller, homemade soaps and a gift shop. Lagou Raxi Country Hotel

Lagou Raxi Country Hotel (330m) opened in 2014 and was built according to the local traditional architecture. It has a breath-taking view of the Pagasitic Gulf and it's also close to the Aegean sea. There is an easy footpath from the hotel down to Milina. Although British owned the hotel cuisine is traditional Greek, sometimes with a twist. All the dishes are home-made, and delicious! The hotel has a good-sized swimming pool and an all-weather tennis court as well as the Library, Terrace, Azure Restaurant, yoga mats and two 'Ateliers'.
